Reverse Engineering. Contractor shall not alter, enhance or otherwise modify the Technical Information or Technical Data, except as agreed by the Parties in writing. In the U.S., Section 103(f) of the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) (17 USC § 1201 (f) - Reverse Engineering) specifically states that it is legal to reverse engineer and circumvent the protection to achieve interoperability between computer programs (such as information transfer between applications). Interoperability is defined in paragraph 4 of Section 103(f).
