UCAS gives a nice explanation here, but in short, this is your chance to stand out against the crowd and show your knowledge and enthusiasm for your chosen area of study.

This assumes that you have one, specific course in mind, because you can only write one personal statement in your application (in most cases - see below when you can write an additional personal statement).

How to write a personal statement that works for ... - UCAS

You can use up to 47 lines of text in your personal statement. Some word processing packages calculate line counts differently from the UCAS Teacher Training system, so you might need to redraft your statement if there's a discrepancy between the counts.

Personal statement FAQ. What is a personal statement? A Ucas personal statement is a short reflective essay you write about why you're the perfect candidate for the university course/s you're applying to. It's a key part of your Ucas application, alongside your predicted or achieved A-level grades (or equivalent) etc.

How to write a Ucas personal statement - Which?

UCAS Personal Statement has a character limit of 4,000 (47 lines, including blank lines). It means you can't exceed this character limit. While writing it, you need to be careful enough to avoid overwriting. In short, make sure you write it precisely.

How to Write a UCAS Personal Statement - A Definitive ...

Understand the UCAS personal statement guidelines. There are specific requirements for your personal statement which you absolutely cannot ignore. You cannot exceed 4,000 characters, or 47 lines of text (including blank lines) - whichever is reached first. If you do, universities won't receive your entire statement.

The character limit which UCAS sets for the personal statement is very strict - up to 4,000 characters of text. This means that students have to express themselves in a clear and concise way; it's also important that they don't feel the need to fill the available space needlessly. Planning and redrafting of a personal statement is essential.
